LINES FROM LAURA

I returned home after my two weeks away for my wedding and honeymoon to find my home garden had changed significantly while I was gone. My tomato plants are now taller than I am, but my kale plants were enjoyed by the local bunnies instead of the humans they were planted for. Such is the life of a gardener.

My raised bed of tomato plants is absolutely overflowing, so it can be hard to see the weeds that have also made it their home. As I've tended to the plants this week, I've found several bindweed shoots. They grow practically overnight and twist their way up, up the tomato plants. If given enough time, they can grow over 20ft and will choke the plants out for good.

My preaching professor in Seminary said that everyone who preaches the gospels should also be a gardener. Now that I'm both, I understand why she said it. When I see the bindweed quickly overtaking the plants I've tended to so carefully, I think of Jesus' parable of the Sower in Matthew 13, where seeds grew up but were choked out by the weeds. The bindweed reminds me how easy it can be for sin, anger, jealousy, or contempt to twist their way into my life. I work *so hard* to cultivate the Fruits of the Spirit, but if I'm not careful, those "weeds" can choke out love, joy, peace, and patience from my life.

How is the garden of your soul these days? What fruits are you cultivating? Are there weeds that have sprung up without you noticing? My therapist once told me that "what we pay attention to grows." I have found that to be true in so many areas of my life. When life is hard (and life is so hard for so many of us right now!), I have to remind myself to pay attention to the things I want more of— more joy, more love, more patience for myself and others, more kindness, more gentleness.

My prayer for you this weekend is that you will take some time to do some good old fashioned soul care. Tend to the garden in your soil- fertilize what you want to see flourish and do the hard work of yanking out the weeds that need to go. And if you have some extra time, I hope you experience the simple joy of getting your hands dirty in God's creation and tending to the beautiful Earth we have to steward.
